HOME ACCESS TO ONLINE DATABASES

FOR MAGAZINE/JOURNAL ARTICLES AND ONLINE DATABASES

- Log on to the Plymouth Public Library homepage www.plymouthpubliclibrary.org
- On the right, click on *Online Resources*.
- Choose an appropriate database and click on the accompanying red button.
- Enter your OCLN library barcode (when required).

As an example:

- From the selection of databases, click on (Under “Arts & Humanities)
Expanded Academic- a database that accesses scholarly journals and more, **or**
General Reference Center- a general interest database that finds articles from newspapers, reference books, and periodicals on current events, popular culture, business, arts and sciences, sports and more.
- Enter your subject area in the *Find* box. Search for words in *Keyword*. Limit your results to *Documents With Full Text*.
- The results of this search will yield articles on your subject from nearly 10,000 credible magazines, journals and newspapers, of which approximately 70% are available online in full-text, simply by clicking text.
- Full-text of the remaining articles, where only an abstract or extended citation is given, can be obtained through the library’s Interlibrary Loan Service, but may require 48 hours or longer to get. Complete an Interlibrary Loan Request Form at the Reference Desk.
- Several other database options are also available. If you have any questions regarding this service, please contact the Reference Department.
